Remembering Local Soldiers of the Great War. Using our archive resources the children investigate local soldiers who are remembered on the Cenotaph in Clifton Park. Another new session is Mini Museum. We take a look at museums and how to display and write information labels. This can be tailored to link with your class history topic.
